## **Book Donation: FORVIA HELLA extends the charity Program to Yongan, Changchun**

During the book selection process, careful considerations are made regarding factors such as the gender distribution among students, the school's size, existing inventory, and specific demands of the school library. In addition to traditional titles, Science Technology Engineering Art Maths (STEAM) elements are infused into the collection, offering rural children's opportunities to develop future-ready skills through reading. Moreover, to foster holistic development in children's physical and mental well-being, an increased emphasis is placed on materials covering children's psychological development, child protection, and knowledge related to physiological health. In addition, the donation also includes various experimental teaching equipment and

online educational resources. The donation benefits over 1500 students and 130 teaching forces.
